

Christmas Wreath Kit

Contents:

- 1 wreath base
- foliage
- garden wire and twine
- A few little extra additions

You may also need:

- Embellishments such as Christmas baubles and ribbons
- Secateurs or sharp scissors
- Something to hang your wreath with





Step 1:

Attach the ribbon to the wreath base by folding it in half, threading the folded end through the willow base and threading the loose ends of the ribbon through the folded end.



Step 2:

Sort the foliage into different types, separating out the conifer, yew, ivy and Norway spruce.



Step 3:

Decide how you want to organise your foliage, you could alternate different types or come up with a pattern of your own, and begin threading it through the base.



Step 4:

We usually thread all of the pieces in the same direction so if you thread your first piece clockwise, do the same with the rest, turning the wreath as you go. Bear in mind that this is just the approach that works for us and it's ok to try something different if you prefer.



Step 5:

Continue to add in the other types of foliage, saving the ivy, holly and anything else pretty or distinctive until the end so that it can be used as a feature



Step 6:

Long Ivy, raffia or string can be used at this stage to wrap and neaten the wreath



Step 7:

Add in any decorative leaves, like holly and ivy or any others you have at home using the garden wire

provided. Twist the wire around the base of the stem and wrap around the wreath wherever you like.



Step 8:

Add in any extra additions such as pine cones dried oranges or any baubles and ribbons you have at home.

Step 9: Enjoy!



Things to remember

- Some of the foliage can cause skin irritation so be sure to wear gloves and long sleeves when you make your wreath and keep everything away from pets and small children.
- We know you already know this but holly can be very spikey! Take extra care not to prickle yourself when handling it.
- We love a natural look for our wreaths but if you want to use glitter make sure to buy edible or biodegradable as it's much kinder to the environment.
- If you're hanging your wreath outside make sure the foliage is secure so it doesn't blow away in the wind.
- Our wreaths are all unique and individual. We aim for a rustic look so don't worry about trying to be perfect, make it your own!
- These instructions are just a guide, feel free to ignore them and do your own thing!
